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Problem Areas

Problem Number: 001

Description: On the final scene index page, the link for Chapter 21 sends you to a spot approx 30 minutes into the movie, should be around 85-90 minutes in.

Priority: B

Problem Number: 002

Description: On the Pioneer DVD Player, chapters 2, 4, 5, 7, 17, 19-22 all have flash frames. On the Toshiba player, only 2, 21, and 22 show them.

Priority: C

Problem Number: 003

Description: The deleted scene named "Steele and Walls on staircase" ends on a frame that is flashing, and stays on that frame for a half-second or so before returning to the menu.

Priority: C

Problem Number: 004

Description: If you leave a menu on for approx 30-40 seconds, it times out to the Main menu build.

Priority: C

Problem Number: 005

Description: Regardless of what screen you were on to begin watching the movie, the Menu button will return you to the Scene Index screen related to the spot in the movie. For example, if you are on the Special Features screen, and hit the Director's Commentary button, the movie will begin playing from the beginning. If you watch the first couple chapters and then hit the "menu" button while viewing Chapter 3, you will be taken to the Scene Index 2-4 screen, as opposed to the Special Features screen which would normally be the case.

Priority: D

Problem Number: 006

Description: On the Special Features page, there is a button to turn on the commentary, but not to turn it off again. Once you have selected the Director's Commentary, you must go back to the main menu and hit Play Movie to turn it off.
